Are you working towards Clubmark and struggling to get people on mandatory courses?

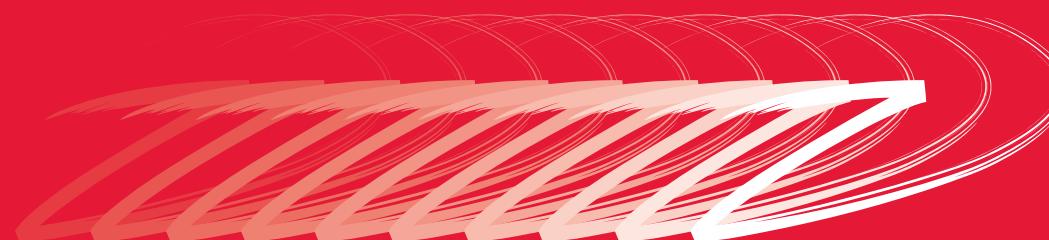
 Are you Clubmark accredited and wondering what the benefits are?
